


#### Overall Patient Satisfaction

\*Based on the percentage of patients that rate us as "Excellent" in Overall Patient Satisfaction


# Catheter-Associated Urinary Tract Infections Q2 • 2016



\*Our number of catheter associated urinary tract infections are below the national average (lower is better)


## Would Recommend this Hospital
