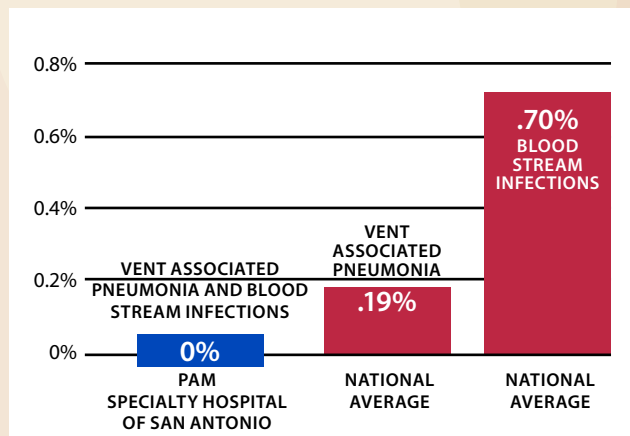

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## Infection Outcomes

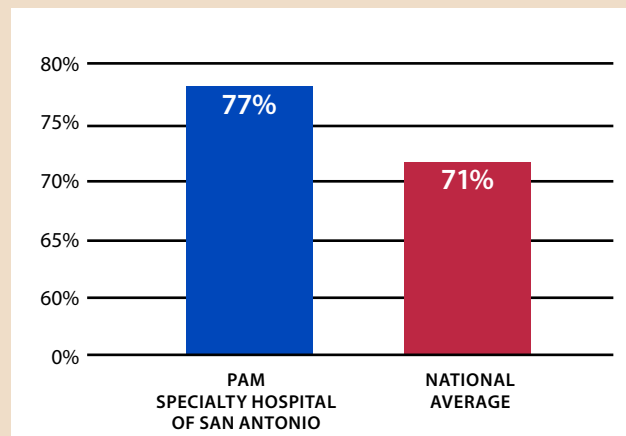
Average Infection Outcomes | Q2 • 2016

Average rating of Hospital | Q2 • 2016

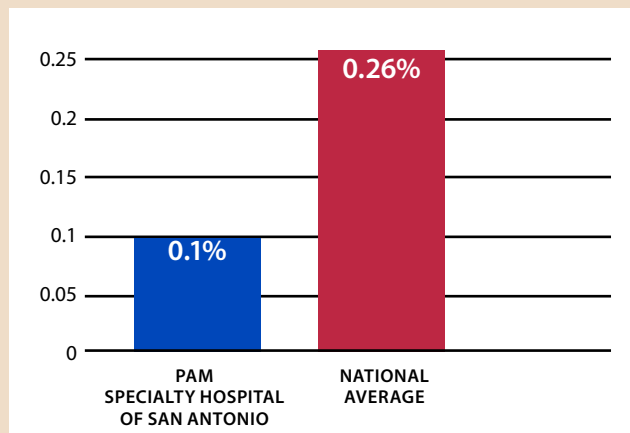

## Hospital Acquired Pressure Ulcer Rate

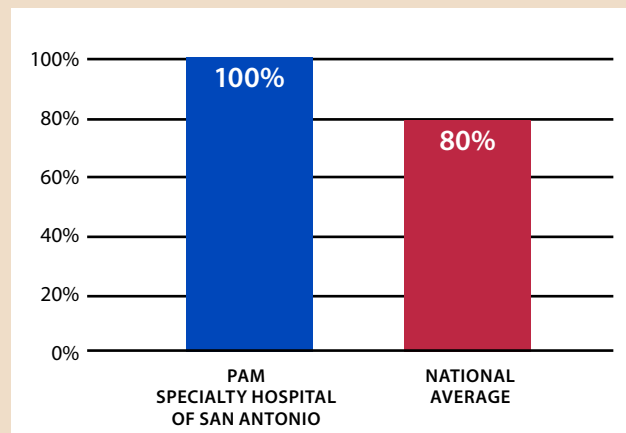
Average Pressure Ulcer Rate | Q2 • 2016

## Patient Success Story – Edgar Machado

Edgar Machado is a Marine veteran that had served several tours in Iraq and Afghanistan. He had just separated from the service and returned home, when he had a vehicle accident in the Brownsville area.
