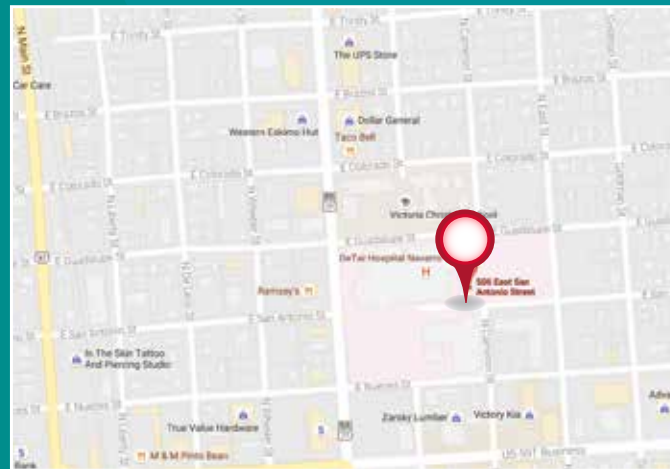

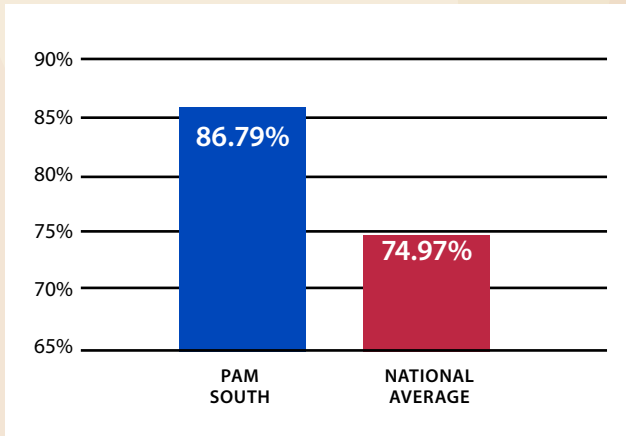

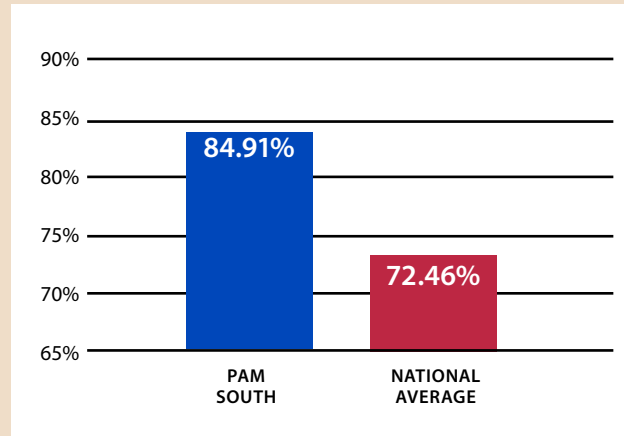

Willingness to Recommend

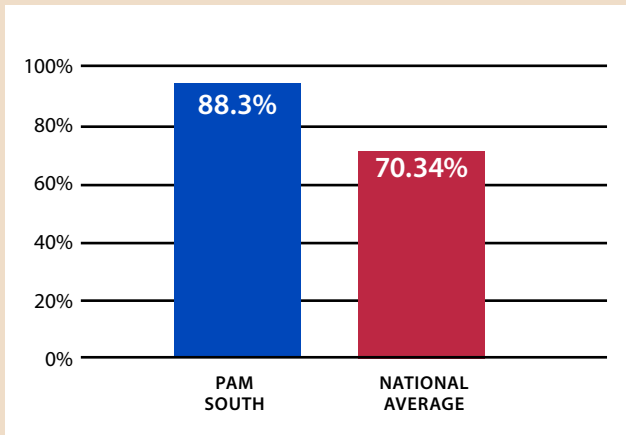

Pain Management

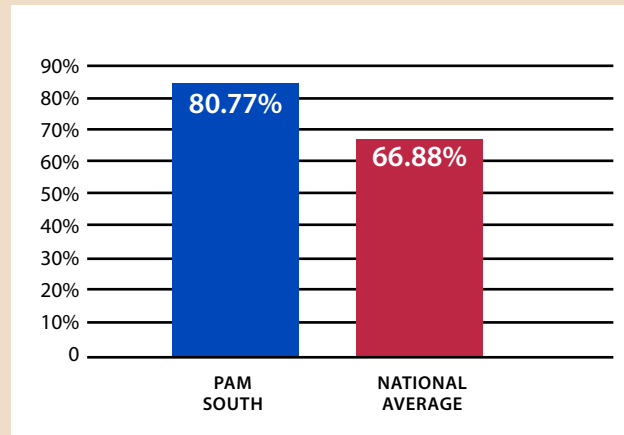

Patient Success Story – Mrs. Henyan

Mrs. Henyan was herding cows on her pasture when one of the cows unexpectedly charged and head butted her in the chest. She sustained a broken neck, broken ribs and a blood clot on the brain, requiring a tracheostomy and ventilator.

After her transfer to PAM Specialty Hospital of Victoria South for vent weaning, nutritional support, and rehabilitation, she was initially debilitated to the point that any movement, even breathing and coughing, caused great pain. Pre-medicating her prior to therapy sessions allowed her to participate fully, and physical therapists began pre-gait training while she was still on the ventilator. Speech and respiratory therapists collaborated with her using the talking valve, as well as eating trials.

By the time Mrs. Henyan was ready to leave PAM Specialty Hospital, she no longer had the trach and was eating independently. She also could walk without an assistive device and was able to complete her basic self-care tasks with minimal assistance. Giving credit to the entire staff for their role in her recovery, she was discharged to the local intensive rehabilitation facility, where she gained strength and endurance, and received the safety training necessary to return home and to all her activities.
